What is phonological awareness?

- "Phonological awareness is the ability to notice and manipulate the sounds in spoken language"
 - California Preschool Curriculum Framework, Vol. 1
- Phonological awareness is highly related to later success in reading and spelling

- The ability to notice and think about sound segments such as words, syllables, onsets, rimes, and phonemes
- A component of phonological awareness


