

2025 CALIFORNIA KINDERGARTEN CONFERENCE

EXHIBIT RULES AND REGULATIONS

Liability: The California Kindergarten Association (CKA), 2025 California Kindergarten Conference (CKC), and its cosponsors shall have no liability whatsoever to any exhibitor for any personal injuries, whether suffered by an exhibitor, their employees or invited business associates; nor any liability for loss or damage resulting from any cause to the property of the exhibition, exhibitor employees or business associates.

Each exhibitor, in making application for table space, agrees to defend, indemnify, and hold harmless CKA, CKC and its cosponsors from any and all claims, liability, damage, or expenses asserted against them or incurred by or injury to persons resulting from, arising out of, or in any way connected to the negligence or wrongful acts of the exhibitor, their agents or employees for any injury to persons or damage to property. The exhibitor will pay attorney's fees and costs required in a defense.

The exhibitor shall care for and keep in good order all space occupied by his/her organization, including the emptying of table trash daily. The exhibitor will be held responsible for all damage done to the building or table space and equipment by them, their employees, or agents. No nails, tacks or screws shall be driven into the walls, woodwork, or floor of the building. Approved tape will be permitted.

CKA, CKC and its cosponsors shall in no event be liable to any exhibitor for any lost profits, sales or business opportunities or any other type of direct or consequential damage alleged to be due to a breach of this contract. It is understood and agreed that the sole liability of CKA/CKC to the exhibitor for any breach of contract shall be for the refund of amounts (as specified at the bottom of the page) paid by the exhibitor.

The California Kindergarten Association, 2024 California Kindergarten Conference and its cosponsors, by entering this contract, do not in any way imply endorsement of any product or service of any exhibitor. Each exhibitor shall defend, indemnify, and hold harmless CKA, CKC and its cosponsors against any claim arising out of the display of a product or service under this agreement.

Insurance and Security: It shall be the responsibility of each exhibitor to maintain insurance coverage against injury to persons or damage to or loss of property or to meet its obligations under this agreement. Each exhibitor must carry insurance with limits of \$1,000,000 combined single limits of \$1,000,000/\$2,000,000 naming California Kindergarten Association as additional insured. Insurance protection will not be afforded by either CKA, CKC, or its cosponsors.

Transportation of Materials: Exhibitors are responsible for transporting their materials to the conference. A maximum of 3 days prior to the show date (1/14/25) materials can be advanced shipped to the hotel. Any materials being sent to the hotel must be marked as follows:

Parking: There are 2000 on-site parking spaces shared with the Hyatt Regency Hotel and Techmart, including 1500 in a three-level garage centered behind the three buildings in the complex. ****Please note that there is a charge for overnight parking.**

Exhibit Hours: Exhibits must remain open and always staffed during the official Exhibition Hours. Exhibitors must remain full time on Sunday and check out with the California Kindergarten Conference Exhibit Chair after 1:30 p.m.

Facilities and Display Information: Each exhibitor has an assigned area which includes an 8' table and 2 chairs. (Additional tables available upon request.) The exhibitor should not use any other area than the space assigned. Exhibitors may only exhibit their own products and services as described on the Exhibit Reservation Form. The exhibitor shall not violate others' space by displays that emit excessive noise, heat, light or pollution. Large displays must be on the back of the exhibit space.

Sales and Order Taking: Exhibitors sell their materials from within their space only. No wandering around to sell goods or entice buyers. Customers must receive a written receipt to remove any product or materials from the exhibition floor. Promotional material, including printed matter and visuals, must be presented in a professional manner. Distribution of samples and other items and the use of promotional activities, such as drawings, are permitted. No advertising information may be distributed outside of the exhibit hall without permission from CKA.

Cancellation Policy: A cancellation fee will be charged for all cancelled booths. Your registration fee will be returned minus 15% of that fee. All cancellations must be made in writing and be postmarked no later than December 31, 2024. After the deadline date no refunds will be granted.
